


WHO ARE WE?

A number of organisations in the greater Duncairn area of North Belfast have worked over the last decade to create a new, inclusive approach to positive regeneration in interface areas. The Duncairn Community Partnership aims to build on improved community relations in the district while providing much needed community resources in one of Belfast's most deprived areas. Two key vacant sites on Duncairn Gardens are earmarked for re-development, offering the prospect of long-term revenue streams to tackle economic inactivity and providing solid foundations for economic growth. Partner groups include Groundwork Northern Ireland, Intercomm, Newington Residents Group, the North Belfast Community Development and Transition Group, the North Belfast Interface Network and Tigers Bay and Mountcollyer Concerned Residents Group.
